The Spokane Education Association (SEA) has designated a \$1,000.00 scholarship for a graduating high school senior from Spokane Public Schools who is a student of color. The applicant must be planning on either a two-year or four-year college degree. This scholarship is available to students pursuing ANY major with the intention of using their voice to serve vulnerable and marginalized populations.

Each applicant must type a 600-word response to a social justice themed essay prompt.

An SEA committee will review completed applications and select the winner. A check will be mailed to the registrar of the college when the student is officially enrolled. If the recipient has not enrolled within one year of high school graduation, the scholarship shall be awarded to a qualified alternate.

This scholarship is intended to support students with a mindset of social and racial justice, and therefore will be awarded to an applicant who demonstrates intentionality and passion towards this goal. Consideration will be given to scholastic ability, financial need, college aptitude, participation in groups and/or activities working toward racial and social justice, and personal traits which are indicators of empathy, advocacy, and action to establish social and racial justice.

A complete application shall include the following:

- Student's application form
- Student's personal statement Form A
- Teaching staff recommendation Form B
- Character reference other than faculty member Form C
- Transcript of grades (official or unofficial)
